REQUEST FOR LICENSED
GENERAL CONTRACTORS AND DEMOLITION CONTRACTORS

The City of Glendale, Community Revitalization Division, through its Voluntary Demolition Program and its Single-Family Rehabilitation Program, is soliciting qualified, Licensed, General Contractors and Demolition Contractors to be placed on the Contractor's List.

The purpose of the Demolition Program is to assist private property owners in removing blighted structures (located within redevelopment areas), that cannot be rehabilitated. The Single Family Residential Rehabilitation Program provides loans, grants, and technical assistance to owner-occupied residences in need of repair and rehabilitation. These are homeowner-driven projects that require the homeowner to solicit bids from licensed general contractors.

These programs are administered by the Community Revitalization Division using Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds and Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) funds. Contractor must be willing to implement Minority and Women-Owned Business guidelines. Proper bonding and insurance is required and verified.
