- IV. Public Hearing on Reallocation of \$53,320 made up of Returned FY2008-2009 and FY2009-2010 Emergency Shelter Funds (ESG) and Unused Administration Funds

Summary: Staff has identified savings and returned ESG funds that can be reallocated to serve the community. These funds are a result of West Valley Child Crisis Center returning shelter operation funds and unused funds from Quality of Life. A savings of last year's administrative funds are also included. Based on community needs identified by Community Information and Referral and the agencies themselves, staff is recommending the funding be reallocated to Central Arizona Shelter Services (CASS) and Faith House Domestic Violence Shelter equally. Major changes to the City's existing 5-Year Consolidated Plan and FY2008-2009 Annual Action Plan must go through an amendment process.

Recommendation: Conduct a public hearing and vote.

- V. Update on Proposed Changes to the West Valley Child Crisis Center's Public Service Contact – Scope of Work

Summary: The West Valley Child Crisis Center (WVCCC) was awarded \$20,329 during the FY 2009-2010 grants process. The WVCCC continues its mission to help abused children through a change in program, necessitated because of program changes initiated by the Department of Economic Security. Based on their situation and the beneficiary of their programs, staff believes that their program continues to provide services to abused children and would ask the committee for their consideration and concurrence.

Recommendation: Information and concurrence.

VI. Distribution of FY2010-2011 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnerships (HOME) and Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG) Application Books

Summary: The CDAC will receive a binder containing the grant applications for their review and related budget information.
