

RESOLUTION NO. 4191 NEW SERIES

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON SEPTEMBER 2, 2008; AND ORDERING THAT A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE RECORDED.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glendale, Maricopa County, Arizona, by Resolution No. 4171, New Series, adopted on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2008, did cause a notice to be submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Glendale (the "City") of a Primary Election called and held in and for the City on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of September, 2008 for the purpose of (1) nominating candidates for the office of Mayor and for the office of council member for the districts of Cactus, Sahuaro and Yucca; and (2) Proposition 404, referring to the voters an initiative submitted by petition proposing an amendment to Article IX of the Glendale City Charter changing the method of voting for city offices (Better Ballot Glendale); and

WHEREAS, the City Council did cause notice of the Primary Election to be given by the City Clerk publishing notice thereof in The Glendale Star newspaper as provided by law, such newspaper published in and having general circulation within said City. Said notice, as so published, did specify the place where such election was to be held and the candidates and the proposition to be voted upon. A copy of said notice, with the affidavit of publication attached thereto, is now on file and a part of the official records of the City Council of Glendale; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said Primary Election, as shown by the cumulative report was 18,620.

SECTION 2. That the total number of ballots rejected was 136.

SECTION 3. That the votes cast for the candidates for Mayor were as follows:


SECTION 9. That it is hereby found, determined, and declared of record that a runoff election for the office of Mayor or councilmember will not be necessary.

SECTION 10. That the City Clerk be instructed and authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution for recording to the Maricopa County Recorder's Office.


