CONVENTIONAL LOW RENT PUBLIC HOUSING!**

The Community Housing Division of the City of Glendale is currently accepting applications for the Conventional Low Rent Public Housing Program. Applications are taken by telephone only by calling 623/930-2199 on Tuesday of every other week between the hours of 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. The waiting list will remain open until further notice. Please note this notice is for conventional public housing only, and does not apply to the Section 8 program.

**PLEASE DO NOT COME TO THE HOUSING OFFICE. APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE
TAKEN IN PERSON AND WILL NOT BE TAKEN AT ANY OTHER TIME OTHER THAN
ON TUESDAY OF EVERY OTHER WEEK BETWEEN THE HOURS STATED ABOVE.**

Federal regulations require that all applicants and any members of their household over the age of sixteen be screened for past criminal histories. Applicants and all members of their household must declare their citizenship status.

Applicants must qualify by earning no more than the following for the members in their family:

Preferences are given for City of Glendale residents who are working or who are disabled, over the age of 62, victims of domestic violence, displaced homemakers, and City of Glendale residents who are displaced by government action or natural disaster. Eligible applicants will be placed on a waiting list and notified when assistance is available. If you have any questions, please call 930-2180.

Persons with a disability may request a reasonable accommodation, such as voice phone through AZ Relay TDD at 1-800-367-8939. Requests should be made early to allow time to arrange the accommodation.
