WOMAN COMMITS ROBBERY AT BANK**

GLENDALÉ, Ariz. - Detectives from the Glendale Police Department have made an arrest in connection to the robbery of the Chase Bank located at 7003 N. 57 Dr. on Monday, 05/04/09.



Florencia Marquez surrendered to police on Sunday, June 7, 2009 after seeing her picture on a news story. Marquez told police she saw the story on a friend's computer and was certain she would be caught so she turned herself in.

Marquez said the reason she robbed the bank was because she was desperate for cash and needed the money to pay bills and help a family member.

On 5/04/2009, Marquez walked up to the teller counter at the bank and demanded money. She did not show a weapon; however, she did tell the bank employee there was a man outside who had a weapon and that she would call for him if the employee did not give her the money. Marquez took the money and fled the scene on foot.
