## **PROGRESS UPDATE**

Meadow Valley Contractors has nearly completed the improvements on 59th Avenue between Melinda Lane and Pinnacle Peak Road. Roadway construction is slated for completion at the end of April 2008 and the landscaping crew will remain onsite until mid-May to complete plant installation.

## **ABOUT THE PROJECT**

The City of Glendale awarded a contract to Meadow Valley Contractors, to improve 59th Avenue between Melinda Lane and Pinnacle Peak Road. Improvements include new asphalt, bike lanes on both sides of the roadway, pedestrian bridge and a new entrance into Thunderbird Park.

## **WORK HOURS**

Please note that the construction work hours now are 7:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

## **NORTHBOUND ROAD CLOSURE PLANNED**

Beginning at 5:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 19, 59th Avenue will be closed to northbound traffic between Melinda Lane and Pinnacle Peak Road. The closure is needed so the contractor can paint new striping on the roadway. Southbound traffic will not be affected by the closure. Northbound 59th Avenue will reopen at 3:00 p.m. the same day.

The speed limit in the work zone is 25 mph so slow down when driving through the area for your safety and the safety of construction crews. *The speed limit will be enforced.* Access will be maintained at all times for residents, businesses and emergency vehicles. Allow yourself time to get where you are going, as there will be traffic delays. In addition, do not move barricades or traffic signs as they are in place for your protection.
