Public Art

Go, Go, Go by Gordon Huether is Glendale's newest public artwork adorns the new Foothills Recreation and Aquatics Center, 5600 West Union Hills Drive.

The Glendale Arts Commission, in collaboration with the City's Parks and Recreation Department and ART Architects, selected Gordon Huether of Napa, CA to create an artwork for the main entrance of the new Foothills Recreation and Aquatics Center. **Go, Go, Go** is made of etched and laminated mouth-blown glass imported from Waldsassen, Germany. The piece is composed of 19 panels and spans the entrance at approximately 14 feet by 16 feet. The imagery features hand-drawn international sports symbols that represent the various activities at the Center.
