Citywide LED Streetlight Conversion Program

Informational Public Meeting

Glendale Engineering is hosting a public meeting to provide information regarding an upcoming project, scheduled to begin in late August 2017 to convert nearly all of the City's 20,200 street lights to LED. This conversion will provide Glendale with lower operating and maintenance costs, and more efficient, reliable street lights for the City's neighborhoods, businesses, and facilities. This project will result in significant annual savings for Glendale.

PROJECT OVERVIEW: Work is expected to begin in late August 2017 and take approximately one year to complete. Conversions will take place during daytime hours with minimal impact to residential streets as crews use an aerial bucket truck to access the street lamp, and will place cones in the area to shift traffic if needed. Some lane restrictions may be required for conversion of street lights on major streets; however, these restrictions will be daytime only during off peak travel hours.
