GLENDALE, Ariz. – The city of Glendale is organizing a volunteer project for National Family Volunteer Day on Saturday, Nov. 21, from 9 a.m. to noon. Volunteers should meet at 9 a.m. in the Foothills Recreation & Aquatic Center lobby located at 5600 W. Union Hills.

Volunteers are needed to help keep Skunk Creek Linear Park clean by picking up trash. Skunk Creek is a great park for walking, horseback riding and biking. It is roughly 3-1/2 miles of trails that connect to the Thunderbird Paseo Park for additional trails. The trail system runs along Skunk Creek, a natural creek bed, so you're likely to see some desert creatures along the way.

This day of service, held annually the Saturday before Thanksgiving, is designed to demonstrate the power of families who choose to volunteer together to support the communities in which they live and serve. Volunteering as a family provides quality time for busy families, strengthens communication and bonds, and positively impacts local communities across the nation. Across the country on this day, thousands of families and individuals will be mobilized to participate in a variety of service projects.
