About the contest

The City of Glendale Conservation and Sustainable Living Office is sponsoring a bookmark contest to celebrate the theme of "My Green Glendale." The bookmark should depict how Glendale residents can live a green lifestyle (e.g. conserving water and energy, gardening, composting, recycling, using alternative modes of transportation, etc.) in an artistic manner.

Who will judge the contest?

Finalists will have their work displayed during the Glendale Green Festival on March 31, 2012 from Noon to 4 p.m. in the auditorium hallway of the Glendale Main Library (5959 West Brown Street). Glendale Green Festival attendees will have a chance to vote for their favorite bookmarks in two categories (1: artwork from students in grades K-4 and 2: artwork from students in grades 5-8). Winners will be notified in April 2012.

What are the prizes?

The top three finalists will receive movie tickets, for a family of four, and have their bookmark designs printed and distributed at the Glendale libraries. All prizes are final and non-negotiable.

Contest Guidelines

Who can enter?

The Bookmark Contest is open to students in grades K through 8 that are Glendale residents.

Must be original, unpublished work

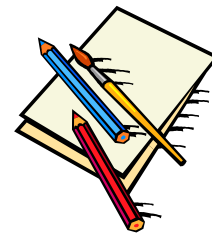
Entries must be original and unpublished. Use of copyrighted characters or logos (ex. SpongeBob, Charlie Brown, etc.) are not permitted. Computer-generated art work is not permitted.

Materials Allowed

Use the bookmark template that is provided (3 x 10 inches). Markers, colored pencils, crayons, felt pens or paint may be used.

What is the subject of the artwork?

If you wanted to show how Glendale residents live a green lifestyle, what images would best illustrate this in an artistic manner?



What are the submission rules?

1. The bookmark contest is limited to one submission per entrant.
2. The bookmark will be representative of the theme, "My Green Glendale."
3. Artwork that includes vulgarity, gratuitous violence, or material considered offensive to any religious or ethnic groups, gender, physically or mentally challenged persons or other social groups will be disqualified.
4. The artist must be in grades K through 8 and a Glendale resident.
5. The artwork must be drawn on the bookmark template that is provided (3 x 10 inches). Artwork that is not the correct size will not be accepted.
6. The artwork must be original: that is, not a copy or a tracing.
7. The artwork cannot contain copyrighted characters or logos (ex. Spongebob, Charlie Brown, etc).
8. Standards for Creating Bookmark:
 - Avoid designs that would be difficult to see or read once they are reproduced
 - Use markers, colored pencils, crayons, felt pens, or paint
 - Use bright/bold colors and, if using pencils, make sure lines are well-defined
 - No computer designs will be accepted
9. Include your first and last name on the back of the bookmark as well as the entry form.
10. Deadline for entries is 5 p.m., March 17, 2012, if hand-delivered to the library OR postmarked by March 17, 2012, if mailed.
11. City of Glendale employees and children of city of Glendale employees are not eligible.
12. Winners will be notified in April 2012.
13. Bookmarks will not be returned.
14. Failure to follow the above rules will result in disqualification.
