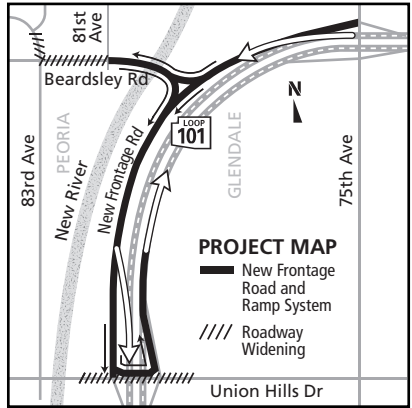
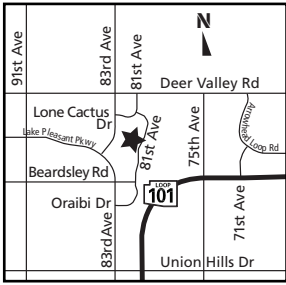




CONSTRUCTION OPEN HOUSE MEETING

LOOP 101 (AGUA FRIA FREEWAY) IMPROVEMENTS

UNION HILLS DRIVE INTERCHANGE AND BEARDSLEY CONNECTOR

Work has begun on a project to improve Loop 101 freeway access between 75th Avenue and Union Hills Drive, reduce bottlenecks at the Union Hills Drive interchange and improve regional freeway access in the Northwest Valley.

The Arizona Department of Transportation, in conjunction with the project partner cities of Peoria and Glendale, will host a public open house Wednesday, Jan. 13 to provide more information about the improvements and an opportunity for the community to meet with staff from ADOT, the cities and the construction team to address questions or concerns about the project or construction.

The improvements include:

- Widening Union Hills Drive at Loop 101 to improve traffic flow;
- Providing new freeway access at Beardsley Road through a new system of ramps and by extending Beardsley Road between 81st Avenue and Loop 101; Northbound Loop 101 access from Beardsley Road will be provided through a new U-turn bridge on-ramp that will allow drivers to bypass the Union Hills Drive interchange;
- Reconfiguring interchange ramps at the 75th Avenue and Union Hills Drive interchanges;
- A new southbound frontage road on the west side of Loop 101 between 75th Avenue and Union Hills Drive;
- A new bridge over the New River, a roundabout at 81st Avenue, widening portions of Beardsley Road and Lake Pleasant Parkway, providing a trail connection along New River and other related improvements.

The \$20.6 million combined improvements are expected to be finished by fall 2011 and are funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.
