Thank you for your interest in performing at the Glendale Folk & Heritage Festival planned for March 20 and 21, 2010, at Sahuaro Ranch Park Historic Area.

The Glendale Folk & Heritage Festival will bring together folk music and entertainment with the rich history and heritage of Sahuaro Ranch Park Historic Area and the City of Glendale. In addition to entertainment, the planning committee is arranging additional activities such as blacksmithing demonstrations, children's crafts and games, food vendors, historic home and property tours and more! The event will be free to the public with nominal charges for merchandise and food.

Please remember that all but one of the entertainment areas are outdoors, so indoor booking space is very limited. If your performance requires use of indoor facilities, please check the "indoors" box on the attached application/registration form. To keep with the "acoustic vision" of the event, **ONLY** certain performance areas will have limited amplified sound provided. You will not be permitted to bring your own sound equipment or plug your instruments into a D.I.

The selection committee requires a brief biography (one page or less). The main purpose of this is to establish a basis for placement at themed entertainment locations and possibly to use for marketing purposes. You will be notified if your name/group is used for a marketing purpose. Please note the selection committee will prioritize acoustic music that celebrates the heritage of traditional, old time, bluegrass, cowboy, folk, storytelling, and Cowboy poetry. Additionally, the committee may request a recording sample (web link or CD) to complete the selection process. **Application deadline is December 15, 2009.** You will be notified if you are selected to perform by January 30, 2010.

Without your help, this event would not be possible. We are asking all performers to volunteer their time and talent at the festival.
