Police asking for help identifying a deceased person

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Detectives from the Glendale Police Department are investigating a possible homicide and are asking for the public’s help in identifying an unknown deceased male.

On June 10, 2009 at approximately 10:00 a.m. Glendale police received a call from a local towing company advising two of their employees found what they believed to be a dead body on a service road near 104th and Glendale Avenues. Investigators confirmed the male was deceased. He is believed to be Hispanic, 25 to 35 years of age, wearing a blue shirt and black pants. He is approximately 5 feet, 6 inches and 150 to 160 lbs.
