Legislative Link Update June 13, 2019

Hello and welcome to the 2019 Glendale Legislative Link Program.

At the conclusion of each legislative session, the city of Glendale Public Affairs Department compiles an annual comprehensive End of Session Report, which provides a session overview, budget highlights and outlines all of the legislation that was introduced during the last legislative session that impacts municipal operations. You will find the bills organized into the areas identified in the City's adopted legislative agenda. The report distinguishes between those categories which bills passed and will become law and those that failed. As you can see from the 76 page report there was a lot of legislative action that was targeted towards municipalities. The new laws will become effective on August 27, 2019, unless the bill contained an otherwise specified effective date. Each of the new laws is assigned a Chapter number in the order of when they were signed by the Governor.
