DOWNTOWN GLENDALE ARTS AND CULTURE FEST OFFERS IMMERSIVE EXPERIENCE FEBRUARY 4 AT MURPHY PARK

Glendale, Ariz. – The Southern Arizona Arts & Cultural Alliance, Local First Arizona, and the city of Glendale are collaborating to bring this memorable and immersive cultural experience to the community. The city of Glendale will host the celebration of arts and culture on February 4, 2023, from 11 a.m. - 8 p.m. Interactive arts will take center stage at the Downtown Glendale Arts & Culture Fest, which will feature over 70 art experiences which include cultural stage showcases, an artisan marketplace, live painting, interactive murals, food trucks and an evening performance featuring fire artists Flam Chen.

ARTIST SPOTLIGHT – FLAM CHEN

A spectacular showcase evening performance will take place by Flam Chen at 6:30 p.m. debuting a new original experience, "Dance On Water - A Journey of Refuge, Restoration, and Renaissance". The collaborative performance will feature elaborate costuming, tightly woven choreography, puppetry, fire arts, stilt-walking, music and other circus and fire arts.

Flam Chen creates a dazzling public spectacle, merging daredevil acrobatics and a mastery of air and fire arts. Their remarkable performances explore narratives which range from the fantastic to the satirical, with skills honed over 20 years of innovation in circus arts. Additionally, performances create a sense of immersion, wrapping the audience in hypnotic visions from dozens of original shows in the troupe's

repertoire. Flam Chen has performed for such luminaries as director Tim Burton and Spiderman/Marvel Comics creator Stan Lee. Chen also hosts and produces international performance artists and collaborates on many projects throughout the year.

The event will feature an artist and vendor market with some of the finest local artisans in fashion, food, home goods, and visual arts.
