City of Glendale Rolls Out Community Alert System

[™]everbridge



The city of Glendale is implementing an emergency notification system to alert citizens to critical situations in the community. Alerts will be provided through email, phone calls or text messages and use geo-targeting to notify citizens of incidents. The system is free and available to anyone who lives, works or spends time in Glendale. To sign up for notifications:

- 1. Download the Everbridge app through the Apple or Google Play Store on a mobile device or sign up through member.everbridge.net/2332343335387137/new
- 2. Type City of Glendale Citizens in the search bar
- 3. Follow the prompts to sign up and select alerting preference (phone call, text message or email)
- 4. Include the associated Glendale address for notifications

Information in the Everbridge app is only used for hazardous or emergency situations by the city's emergency management team and contact information is never shared. The system does not receive messages. INFO: www.glendaleaz.com/emergency-management.

GLENDALE UNIVERSITY 101 RESUMES!

I invite all Glendale residents and business owners to save the date for the Spring 2024 Glendale University 101 program. The GU101 application process will open soon, so keep an eye out for it.

GU101 is a ten-week program sponsored by Arizona State University that is open to everyone who resides or owns a business in Glendale. During the ten-week course, participants learn more about the city's innerworkings and get an inside look at each department's operations, as well as meet the staff who make it all happen. Each week's class will be held in a different facility in the city and will include a tour of that facility.

The Spring 2024 GU101 classes will be held from 6-9 p.m. on Wednesdays beginning March 6, 2024, through May 8, 2024. Classes are free and limited in size to encourage interaction among participants and the city staff who teach each unit.

To participate in GU101, you must be a Glendale resident age 18 or older or own a business in Glendale. Attendees who complete eight of the ten GU101 classes will be honored during a GU101 graduation ceremony held on the final night of class.
