City Office Hours and Schedule Changes

GLENDALE, Ariz. - City of Glendale offices will be closed Monday, Feb. 17, in observance of President's Day.

Valley Metro buses and Light Rail will operate on normal weekday schedules on President's Day, Monday, Feb. 17. However, there will be no Express or Rapid service available. GUS Bus 1 will also operate on a normal weekday schedule, from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. GUS 2 and 3 will not be available on President's Day. For Dial-a-Ride service Monday, Feb. 17, reservations must be made in advance by noon Friday, Feb. 14. Reservations can be made by calling Glendale's Transit Services at 623-930-3500. ADA service will be available on the holiday and will be based on a weekday fixed route schedule. No same-day service will be available Monday, Feb. 17. ADA reservations can be made by calling Glendale's Transit ADA Services at 623-930-3515.

While the Glendale Municipal Airport will remain open, the airport administration building will be closed. In addition, Glendale's four public library branches and the Glendale Visitors Bureau will close in observance of the holiday.
