HOLIDAY HOURS: MEMORIAL DAY *City of Glendale Office Hours, Services and Schedule Changes*

GLENDALE, AZ: The city of Glendale offices will be closed on Monday, May 26, in observance of the Memorial Day holiday, but many city services and facilities, including pools and splash pads, will be open for residents' convenience and recreation. City offices will reopen on May 27.

All residential garbage, recycling and bulk trash collection services will take place as usual on May 26. The Glendale Municipal Landfill and the Solid Waste customer service office will be closed on May 26 in observance of the holiday. For the convenience of anyone who needs public transportation on Memorial Day, Valley Metro fixed route and GUS Bus 1 vehicles will operate on a holiday schedule on May 26. GUS Bus routes 2 and 3 will not be running on Memorial Day. There will be no Express/RAPID bus service offered on May 26. Glendale MicroTransit (Dial-A-Ride) service will be available by reservation only on Memorial Day, and reservations must be made by noon on May 21. However, the Glendale MicroTransit (Dial-A-Ride) office will be closed on Memorial Day. ADA service will be unaffected on May 26. Glendale Public Libraries will be closed on Memorial Day and will reopen on May 27.

There is great news for anyone who wants to cool off, have fun with their loved ones and get some exercise over Memorial Day weekend. The Foothills Recreation and Aquatics Center at 5600 W. Union Hills Drive and Rose Lane Aquatics Center at 5003 W. Marlette Ave. will be open from 1 to p.m. on May 24, 25 and 26, and then those same hours from June 3 to July 26. The city of Glendale's splash pads will be open from noon to 7 p.m. May 24 to July 27 and those same hours Saturdays, Sundays and Labor Day from July 28 to Sept. 1. Glendale's splash pads are located at Greenway Granada Park at 73rd Avenue and Greenway Road; Heroes Regional Park at 83rd Avenue and Bethany Home Road; O'Neil Park at 64th and Missouri avenues; Sunset Palms Park at 54th and Sweetwater avenues and Sycamore Grove Park at 86th Lane and Emil Rovey Parkway.
