HOLIDAY HOURS: FOURTH OF JULY *City of Glendale Office Hours, Services and Schedule Changes*

GLENDALE, AZ: The city of Glendale offices will be closed on Friday, July 4, in observance of the Fourth of July holiday, however many city facilities and services will still be operating for residents' convenience and entertainment.

All residential garbage, recycling and bulk trash collection services will be offered at regularly scheduled collection times on the holiday. The Glendale Municipal Landfill and the Solid Waste customer service office will be closed on Friday, July 4, in observance of the holiday. For those who need public transportation on July 4, GUS Bus route 1 will operate on a Sunday schedule, but GUS Bus routes 2 and 3 will not be in service. There will be no Valley Metro Express/RAPID bus service available on the Fourth of July. Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) public transportation service in Glendale will not be affected by the holiday. Valley Metro bus service will run on a Sunday schedule. The Glendale MicroTransit (Dial-A-Ride) office will be closed. MicroTransit (Dial-A-Ride) service will be available by reservation only, and reservations must be made by noon on July 3. Glendale Public Libraries will be closed on July 4 and will reopen at 10 a.m. on July 5.

Residents can cool off and have fun in the city's two pools, which will be open from 1 to 5 p.m. on July 4. The Foothills Recreation and Aquatics Center is located at 5600 W. Union Hills Drive and Rose Lane Aquatics Center is located at 5003 W. Marlette Ave. Glendale's splash pads will be open from noon to 7 p.m. on the Fourth of July. The city has splash pads at these sites: Greenway Granada Park at 73rd Avenue and Greenway Road, Heroes Regional Park at 83rd Avenue and Bethany Home Road, O'Neil Park at 64th and Missouri avenues, Sunset Palms Park at 54th and Sweetwater avenues, and Sycamore Grove Park at 86th Lane & Emil Rovey Parkway. Glendale's community and recreational centers will be closed on July 4. For more information about Parks and Recreation services and programs, call 623-930-2820.

The Glendale Municipal Airport will remain open on the Fourth of July, as it is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week year-round. However, the airport administrative office will be closed on July
