## **FIRE INVESTIGATORS ARREST SUSPECT WHO ADMITS TO IGNITING FIRE**

**Glendale, Ariz.** — The Glendale Fire Investigations Division has arrested a suspect who has admitted to having set fire to an occupied structure on April 30, 2013.

Fire crews were dispatched to a residence located at 6700 North 59 Drive after a fire was started deliberately in a storage shed. The fire quickly spread to dry oleanders, others storage sheds on the property and finally to an occupied duplex.

The suspect, who lives at the residence with his girlfriend, admitted to officials that he ignited the shed, which was occupied as a living space by a mutual friend. The friend suffered minor burns to his leg but refused treatment by on-scene paramedics.

Witnesses identified the suspect, who fled the scene prior to the fire and police departments' arrival.

Glendale Fire and Glendale Police are working together on this case as the suspect has multiple criminal charges in connection with this case.
