## **GLENDALE FIRE HONORS FIREFIGHTERS, EMS WORKERS WHO DIED BY SUICIDE**

**Glendale, Ariz.** — On May 20, 2016, at 9:00 p.m., the Glendale Fire Department participated in Firefighter Behavior Health Alliance's 2nd Annual "We Remember Night" in recognition of Mental Health Awareness month. "We Remember Night" is an opportunity to express support for all the families of firefighters and EMS workers that have suffered a loss due to suicide by placing emergency vehicles on the station's driveway and turning on the emergency lights for one minute. Every fire department vehicle not assigned to an incident participated.

Founded by Jeff Dill, a retired Fire Captain from Inverness, IL, the Firefighter Behavioral Health Alliance (FBHA) educates firefighters and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel, and their families, about behavioral health issues as well as firefighter suicides.

According to their website, the FBHA's goal is to provide behavioral health workshops to fire departments and EMS organizations across the globe, focusing on behavioral health awareness with a strong drive towards suicide prevention and promoting resources available to firefighters/EMS workers and their families.
