GLENDALE FIRE DEPARTMENT DEPLOYS TO WILDFIRES

Glendale, Ariz. —Glendale Firefighters have been sent to the River Complex Fire in Willow Creek, CA. A total of five have been sent to the fire and perform various support duties based on their credentials and qualifications within the U. S. Forest Service fire management group.

Four of the team members are ranked as security and prevent unwanted access from civilians that may be in the firefighting area. One member is an equipment manager and is stationed at the base camp issuing necessary items for firefighting support.

Glendale Fire does have wild land firefighters that serve on the fire lines with a deployable brush truck. These teams can dig fire lines, saw trees, clear brush, and apply water however; they are currently not assigned to any fires at this time.
