NIGHTTIME ROAD CLOSURES

GLENDALE AVENUE

57TH DRIVE TO 57TH AVENUE

1/8/18 - 1/11/18

Beginning Monday, January 8 through Thursday, January 11, Glendale Avenue between 57th Drive and 57th Avenue will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning to accommodate the installation of storm drain pipe. During this time, 57th Drive and 57th Avenue will remain open. Through traffic may use Lamar Road, Glenn Drive, 58th Avenue or 56th Avenue as an alternate route. Please allow extra time to get where you are going as there may be traffic delays. Do not remove any barricades or traffic signs. They are in place for your protection.

PROJECT SCOPE

This community enhancement project will reconstruct the existing alley connecting Glendale Avenue and Glenn Drive (between 57th Drive and 57th Avenue) to create a more accessible and pedestrian-friendly environment for Downtown Glendale visitors. Improvements include the removal of existing asphalt pavement and the installation of landscaping, decorative brick pavers, ornamental screen walls, new street lighting, pedestrian seating and drainage improvements. Construction activities began in August and the project is slated for completion in January 2018. Work hours are 6 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. Some evening or weekend work may be required to accommodate nearby businesses and neighbors.

TEMPORARY ALLEY CLOSURE

In the interest of public safety and to protect the worksite, a fence has been installed around the construction work area. During this upgrade project, there will be no public or business access to the alley until the project is completed.
