\$2,500 Reward

Offered in Exchange for Information Leading to the Arrest and Conviction of the Individuals Responsible for the Armed Robbery of Arizona Federal Credit Union



Glendale, Arizona - On September 1, 2015, two white adult male suspects entered the Arizona Federal Credit Union located at 5485 W. Northern Avenue. Both suspects were armed with handguns. One suspect fired one shot into the air striking the ceiling. The suspect then approached a teller with the handgun pointed at the teller and demanded money. The suspects were given an undisclosed amount of money. Both suspects then left the bank and fled the area in a silver colored Dodge Intrepid. This vehicle was located a short time later and a short distance away abandoned and on fire.

The suspects are described as two white male adults, 5'10" to 6'0" tall, with medium builds, appearing to be in their 20's, wearing bandanas over their faces (See above pictures).

The suspect vehicle was stolen from the 6900 block of West McDowell Rd, Phoenix, Arizona between 7 p.m. on 8/31/2015 and 2 a.m. on 9/1/2015. The suspect vehicle was a silver colored Dodge Intrepid.

The FBI Bank Robbery Task Force and Glendale Police Department are conducting a joint investigation into this armed bank robbery. The public is encouraged to call 623-466-1999 (FBI), 623-930-3000 (Glendale P.D.), or Silent Witness at 480-Witness with any information that may help investigators solve this case.

A \$2,500 reward is being offered in exchange for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the individuals responsible for this armed robbery.
