Glendale Police Department Entering CALEA Re-Accreditation Process

GLENDALE, Ariz. – A team of assessors from the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA) will arrive April 23, 2012 to examine all aspects of the Glendale Police Department. This examination will include an assessment of the department’s policies, procedures, management, operations, and support services.

This assessment is part of a voluntary process to gain accreditation, a highly prized recognition of professional excellence in the field of law enforcement. The goal of the assessment is to demonstrate that the Glendale Police Department is in compliance with over 400 professional standards established by CALEA. The Glendale Police Department was first accredited in the year 2000; the department’s accredited status was reaffirmed in the years 2003, 2006, and 2009.
