Glendale Police Department to Host Crime Free Multi-Housing Program Workshops

Glendale, Az. The Glendale Police Department Community Action Team will be hosting a series of crime free multi-housing program workshops.

The program educates rental and manufactured home communities on how to keep illegal activity off their property and improve their neighborhood by reducing crime. New in 2010 is the four-hour manager's recertification/renewal class.

The crime free multi-housing program workshops are **free** and all attendees must be pre-registered. Workshops will be held at the Glendale Regional Public Safety and Training Center located at 11550 W. Glendale Avenue. Workshops began in January 2010; however, two additional 8 hour phase one workshops will be conducted, Wednesday, April 21, 2010 and Wednesday, September 22, 2010 from 7:45 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.

The new 4 hour renewal workshop is intended for managers whose certification expires within 3 months of the training class. There will be two 4 hour manager certification renewal training sessions. These will be held on Wednesday, April 21, 2010 and Wednesday, September 22, 2010 from 7:45 a.m. until noon.
