## **Glendale Police Department Receives Grant From the Governor's Office of Highway Safety**

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – The Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) has awarded the Glendale Police Department with a \$10,000.00 grant for seat belt and child restraint violations enforcement.

The "Click it or Ticket" Program focuses on seat belt and child restraint violations. Officers from the Glendale Police Department are partnering up with GOHS to conduct enhanced enforcement of passenger restraint laws on City of Glendale roadways. This will be carried out during the Click It or Ticket effort taking place May 18<sup>th</sup> -31<sup>st</sup> and Child Passenger Safety Week taking place September 19<sup>th</sup> -26<sup>th</sup>.

Glendale Police officers will be patrolling various parts of the city to ensure seat belts and child restraints are being used. People are encouraged to wear safety restraints while traveling in their vehicles to reduce the possibility of serious injury if they happen to become involved in a vehicle accident. The goal of this enforcement effort is to educate the public on the importance of passenger restraint devices.
