Glendale Investigates Fatal Accident

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On December 6th, 2016 at approximately 2:06 AM, Glendale Police responded to a collision in the area of 5100 W Peoria. Glendale Fire responded to treat the injured. Four subjects were transported to local hospitals with varying injuries. 45 year old Phoenix resident, Poe Glay, was later pronounced deceased due to the injuries from the accident. The other three involved in the crash sustained non-life threatening injuries.

Glendale Vehicular Crimes Detectives assumed the investigation. Thus far, the investigation has revealed that a red sedan, driven by Poe with a female passenger, was traveling eastbound on West Peoria. The sedan was passing through the intersection as it was struck by a gray SUV that was traveling southbound on North 51st Avenue. The accident caused the SUV to flip over and pushed the sedan into the bus lane.

The SUV was occupied by two individuals and was being driven by 22 year old Jodie Ramsey. Jodie and the passenger were also transported. Jodie did show signs of impairment on scene.

Charges will be determined based on the investigation and pending blood results.

The investigation is on-going for impairment, and speeds.
