Glendale Investigates Fatal Motorcycle Accident

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On June 10, 2018 at approximately 12:20 a.m., Glendale Police responded to a collision near 7300 W. Bell Road involving two vehicles. Upon arrival, patrol units determined a motorcyclist on W. Bell Road had rear-ended a pick-up truck that was traveling in the same direction. The motorcyclist was wearing a helmet, but was transported to a local valley hospital with life threatening injuries, where he was shortly pronounced deceased. The male rider was identified as 30-year-old Peoria resident, Jason Cooper.

Glendale Police Vehicular Crimes Detectives determined the motorcycle was traveling westbound on Bell Road and the speed of the motorcycle was a contributing factor to the accident. The investigation is ongoing at this time and it is unknown if there was any impairment.
