Glendale Investigates Fatal Motorcycle and Pedestrian Accident

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On March 16, 2017 at approximately 6:15PM, Glendale Police responded to a traffic collision in the area of 5900 W. Berridge Lane. The Glendale Fire Department responded to treat two males involved in the accident. The male motorcycle rider was identified as 20-year-old, Dustin Scherr. The male pedestrian was identified as, 52-year-old Glendale resident, Philip Wilson. Both men were treated initially on scene and then transported to a local valley hospital with life-threatening injuries. They were both later pronounced deceased that evening.

Glendale Police Vehicular Crimes Detectives determined the motorcycle was traveling northbound on 59th Ave from W. Bethany Home Road and struck Wilson who was crossing eastbound on N. 59th Ave at Berridge Ln. Speed is believed to be a contributing factor to the crash, impairment is still being investigated.

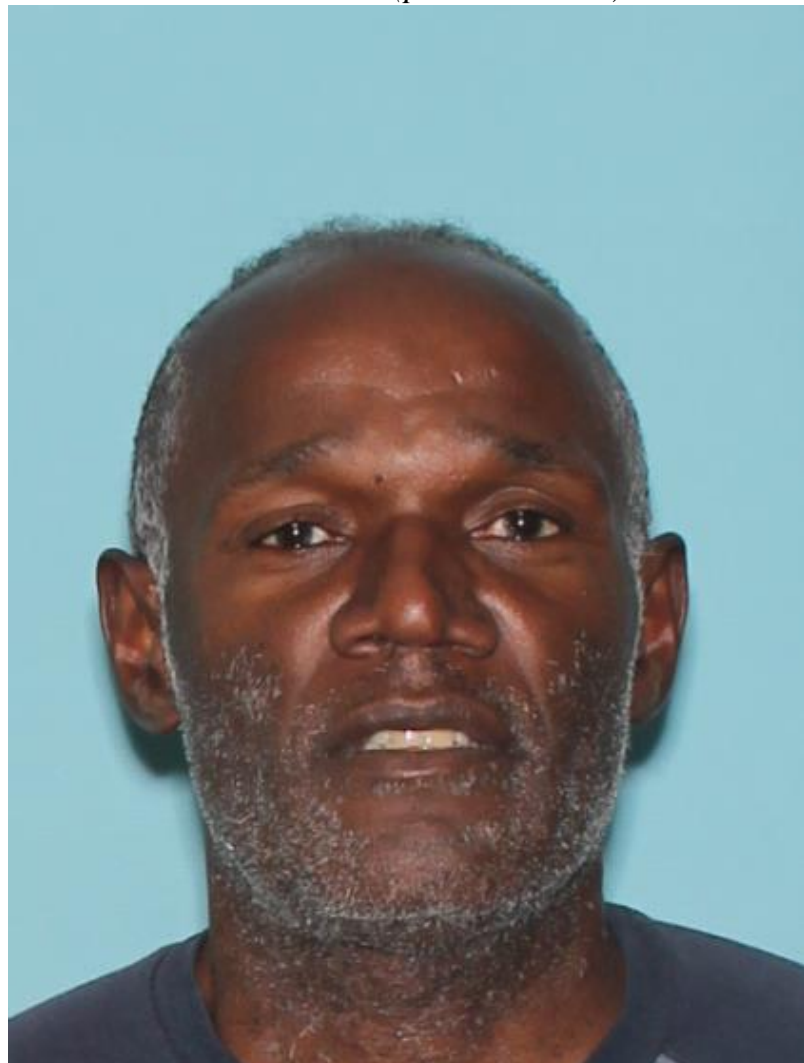
