Glendale Police Detectives Arrest Neighbor for Sexual Assault

Glendale, Ariz. – On June 11, 2016, Glendale Police detectives arrested 33 year old Noe Rodriguez Garcia at his Glendale residence in the 4500 block of W. Ocotillo Road. This was related to the sexual assault of an adult female neighbor earlier that morning.

The female neighbor reported that she was awoken in her home with Garcia on top of her. She reported he came back to her residence later in the morning and she began yelling that he had sexually assaulted her. An unknown subject then assaulted Garcia. Police were able to follow his blood trail to his home and checked welfare on him. Garcia was treated at a local valley hospital.

Through their investigative efforts, detectives working the case were able to develop probable cause for the arrest of Noe Rodriguez Garcia. Search warrants were obtained and served on Garcia for biological evidence and other items of evidentiary value.

Garcia was booked into the Maricopa County jail and charged with two felony counts; one count of sexual assault, one count of 2nd degree burglary, and one count of misdemeanor assault.
