## Glendale Police Arrest Rickey Brisbon

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – On December 19<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at approximately 12:40 am, Glendale Police Officers responded to a residence in the 200 block of W. Turney Avenue in the city of Phoenix reference a call of a sexual assault that allegedly occurred in Glendale. A female victim alleged that 38 year old Glendale resident Rickey McGee Brisbon had physically and sexually assaulted her. The victim also made allegations that Rickey Brisbon had made threats to kill her and kill the Phoenix Police Officer that shot his brother Romain Brisbon.

Rickey Brisbon was contacted today by Glendale Police Detectives at his residence in the 8800 block of New World Drive. He was taken into custody without incident and questioned by Detectives. Glendale Police Detectives have not established Probable Cause at this time for arrest of Brisbon for charges related to the allegations of sexual assault and threats. Those allegations are still being investigated, and the investigation is ongoing. The Glendale Police Department did make notification to the Phoenix Police Department of the alleged threats made upon their police officer.

Rickey Brisbon was arrested and booked this evening into the Glendale City Jail on an unrelated misdemeanor charge of Domestic Violence / Interference with Judicial Proceedings. Brisbon violated his release conditions from a June 2013 Domestic Violence / Aggravated Assault that occurred in Glendale. The victim in 2013 domestic violence case is not the same alleged victim in this case currently being

investigated. Brisbon was also booked on felony possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia. He will be transferred to the Maricopa County 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Jail later this evening.
