## Glendale Police Detectives Make Arrest in Sexual Assault

**Glendale, Ariz.** – On March 20, 2017, Glendale Police Detectives arrested 26-year-old Jorge Lopez Nunez at his Glendale residence in the 8100 block of N. 61<sup>st</sup> Ave. This was related to the sexual assault of an adult female on March 11<sup>th</sup> at approximately 2:50AM.

On the morning of March 11<sup>th</sup>, residents from the apartment complex had called in hearing screams of a female in the complex. Glendale patrol officers responded and checked the original possible location. After checking welfare where the initial calls came in, they were able to locate the victim, who resided in a different building. She reported that she was awoken in her home with Nunez pulling her down her bed towards him. She reported he kept her from seeing his face during the entire incident by physically forcing her to look away from him. She attempted to fight back and get away from her assailant, causing injuries and ripping off buttons from his shirt.

Through their investigative efforts, detectives working the case were able to develop probable cause for the arrest of Jorge Lopez Nunez. Search warrants were obtained and served on Nunez for biological evidence and other items of evidentiary value. Clothing the victim described the suspect wearing during the incident was also recovered.

Nunez was booked into the Maricopa County jail and charged with three felony counts; one count of sexual assault, one count of 2<sup>nd</sup> degree burglary, and one count of kidnapping.
