Glendale Police Investigate Family Shooting

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On January 8, 2017 at 6:20 PM, Glendale Officers responded to the area of 7600 West Paltaire for a shooting. They arrived on scene and found 53 year old male, William Carroll, had sustained multiple gun shot wounds. William was transported to a local hospital but was declared deceased due to the injuries.

Also on scene was 22 year old male, Joseph Langenbach, who told investigators that he was the one who shot William. Joseph was cooperative on scene and was taken to the main station for questioning. The home was searched and multiple firearms were located inside the home.

Interviews with witnesses on scene and Joseph revealed that an argument happened in the home between his father, William, and his mother. During that argument William displayed a firearm. Joseph witnessed the display and responded by shooting William. Joseph was interviewed and released. The Maricopa County Attorney's Office will be reviewing the case and will file appropriate charges, if any.
