Glendale Police Investigate Fatal Shooting

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On Sunday, July 8, 2018 at approximately 8:12 PM, Glendale Police received a call in the area of 5700 N. 67th Avenue regarding a subject that had been shot. Upon Glendale Officers arriving on scene, two adult males were found to have been shot. One of the males was suffering from a life-threatening injury and the second received a non-life-threatening injury. Fire personnel treated the males on scene and transported them both to a local valley hospital. Once at the hospital the male suffering from the life-threatening injury did succumb to his injuries and passed away. The second victim is recovering at this time.

Witnesses reported that there was an altercation between the suspect and both victims just prior to the shooting. The suspect did flee the scene prior to police arrival and is currently outstanding. Information regarding the suspect is being withheld at this time as detectives continue with the investigation. The victim's names are also being withheld as next of kin and family are notified. More information will become available in the near future.
