Glendale Police Investigate School Threat

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On February 27, 2018 one of our School Liaison Officers was contacted by the school administration from Apollo High School about a potential threat posted to social media the previous evening.

The Glendale Police Department has been working with the administrators from the Glendale Union High School District through the course of the investigation. Our detectives are working diligently to identify the source of the potential threat. Investigators have discovered that the photograph used to incite fear of the potential threat was a google image search photo and not believed to be associated with any student or person related to the campus.

The GUHSD and the Glendale Police Department are working closely together to ensure the safety of all students and staff at Apollo High School, as well as other schools within our jurisdiction.

Incidents like this highlight the importance of maintaining open lines of communication with students to ensure comfort in sharing information of this nature with administrators and police.
