Glendale Police Investigate Shooting That Turns Fatal

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On Friday, January 5, 2018, at approximately 11:20 PM, Glendale Police received a 911 call in the area of 7400 N 44th Drive that a male had been shot. Police located one adult male, who sustained a life-threatening gunshot wound. Glendale Officers and Glendale Fire personnel responded to the scene. Glendale Fire treated the male on scene and transported him to a local valley hospital.

Glendale Police Detectives assumed the investigation. They did recover shell casings and ammunition on scene. Detectives also found that an additional round did enter a near-by residence, striking a second victim. That victim was treated for minor injuries. The male who was on scene did later succumb to his injuries at the hospital and was identified as Austin Dewayne Behn, 59 years old.

Witnesses reported seeing a black male fleeing the area of the scene.
