Glendale Police Make Arrest in Afternoon Shooting

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On July 11th, 2014, at approximately 1:30pm in the afternoon, Glendale Police received a 911 call of a shooting at a residence in the 8200 block of N. 49th Avenue. Upon arrival, officers contacted the 911 caller, 24 year old Alex Luke Felter, standing outside his residence. Officers were directed inside the residence where they located the girlfriend of Alex Felter, 22 year old Deanna Aguilar, a resident of Phoenix. Deanna had sustained a gunshot wound and was declared deceased at the scene by Glendale Fire. There were no other individuals located inside the residence. Alex Felter was detained at the scene and later questioned by Detectives.

Investigators from the Glendale Police Violent Crimes Unit assumed the investigation. Alex Felter has been talking with Detectives, and they are still looking into the motive for this shooting. Information and evidence obtained by Detectives leads them to believe at some point this afternoon while Alex and Deanna were at the residence together, Alex produced a weapon and shot and killed his girlfriend Deanna. Detectives working the case have established probable cause for the arrest of Alex Felter. He is being charged with 2nd Degree Murder and will be booked this evening into the 4th Avenue Jail.

Glendale Police Detectives are still actively working this case, conducting interviews, and processing the scene. The investigation is ongoing.
