Glendale Police Release Name in Fatal Collision

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On Tuesday, December 2nd, 2014 at approximately 2:20am, Glendale Police responded to the area of 5900 West Glendale Avenue after receiving a report of a single vehicle crashed into a business. Officers found that the driver, and sole occupant, of the vehicle had suffered life-threatening injuries. He was transported to a nearby hospital where he later was later declared deceased. He was identified as 47 year-old Sean Brannen of Phoenix.

The Glendale Police Department's Vehicular Crimes Unit responded to investigate the crash. It appears that Brannen had been driving his Ford truck westbound on Glendale Avenue and veered across into the eastbound lanes. His vehicle then left the roadway, striking a concrete water well and then the barber shop where it came to rest. Speed and impairment do not appear to be factors in the collision, but any possible medical issues are unknown at this time.

Glendale Avenue was closed from 59th to 63rd Avenues for several hours but has since reopened. The Imperial Barber Shop sustained only minor damage to its exterior.
