Glendale Police Responds to Fatal Collision on Camelback

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On October 14, 2016, at approximately 7:30 PM, Glendale Police responded to a collision in the area of 5900 W Camelback. Glendale Fire responded to treat the injured. Four subjects were transported to local hospitals with varying injuries. Later that night, a 17 year old female, was declared deceased at the hospital, due to injuries sustained in the collision. Another passenger, a 16 year old male was also pronounced deceased from the accident. The other occupants sustained non-life threatening injuries.

Glendale Vehicular Crimes Detectives assumed the investigation. Thus far, the investigation has revealed that the gray sedan, occupied by 4 individuals, was traveling westbound on West Camelback. The sedan attempted to make a left turn to go south onto North 59th Avenue. The sedan collided with a green truck that was traveling eastbound on West Camelback. The truck collided with the passenger side of the gray sedan.

The truck was being driven by 27 year old Roberto Peredes. Roberto was treated on scene for injuries but not transported. Roberto did show signs of impairment on scene. He was taken to the police station for further investigation.

Charges will be determined based on the investigation and pending blood results.

The investigation is on-going for impairment, and speeds. Due to the age of the victims the names will not be released.
