## Glendale Police Respond to Fatal Collision

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – On February 20, 2017 at approximately 6:35AM, Glendale Police responded to an accident involving a single vehicle and a pedestrian in the area of 5400 W. Camelback Avenue. The male pedestrian was identified as 58 year old Glendale resident, Lawrence Massaro. Massaro was treated on scene by the Glendale Fire Department, but was pronounced deceased due to the injuries from the accident at the scene.

Glendale Police Vehicular Crimes Detectives determined the silver vehicle, being driven by 21 year old Glendale resident, Jasmine Harpe, was traveling eastbound. The vehicle struck Massaro as he was crossing the road, going south, mid-block. Jasmine remained on scene and cooperated with the investigation. It does not appear that impairment was a factor in the collision.

The Vehicular Crimes Detectives will continue to investigate the incident to determine if any other factors contributed to the accident. We encourage all drivers to be extra vigilant when driving. We also encourage all pedestrians to use the designated crosswalks and be mindful of traffic.
