Glendale Police Seek Help Solving Serious Injury Hit and Run

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On Tuesday, February 6, 2018 approximately 6:00 a.m., an adult female was struck and seriously injured on N. 59th Avenue between Olive and Northern Avenues.

The investigation revealed the victim was on N. 59 Avenue, at or near a crosswalk, when she was struck by a northbound vehicle. The driver of the vehicle failed to stop and seek help for the victim, who was injured from the collision. The driver and vehicle, instead, fled northbound on N. 59 Avenue.

Glendale Police Vehicular Crimes Investigators gathered evidence from the scene, which included damaged vehicle parts. At this time, investigators have not determined the make or the model of the fleeing vehicle, which is possibly metallic silver in color. However, investigators believe the vehicle sustained noticeable damage to the front end.
