## Glendale Police Seek Help in Hit-and-Run Accident

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – On April 7, 2017, the Glendale Police Department responded to area of 5200 W Camelback for an accident between a vehicle and a pedestrian. The incident occurred around 7:30 PM. They arrived and found an adult female pedestrian in critical condition. She was transported to a local hospital and remains in critical condition.

As the investigation unfolded, it was determined the pedestrian was struck in the roadway by a white vehicle, that fled the scene. The vehicle was traveling westbound during the collision. The vehicle is described as a 2000-2005 Subaru 4 door sedan. The vehicle will have sustained front end damage and a broken windshield. The vehicle is believed to have a spoiler on the back that is raised about three inches.

The vehicle was believed to be driven by a white or light-skinned Hispanic female with dark hair. The driver is believed to be anywhere from 20-30 years old.
