Glendale Police Seek Help in Hit and Run Accident

Glendale, Ariz. – On July 16th, 2015, at approximately 8:17 pm, Glendale Police received a call of a pedestrian accident in the area of 6700 W. Bethany Home Road. On arrival, the investigation revealed a 15 year old teenager was attempting to cross N. 67th Avenue, at the mid-block outside of a crosswalk, when he was struck by two northbound vehicles. The first vehicle, described as a tan/white/grey 4-door midsize passenger car with dark tint, did not stop after impact but instead continued north on N. 67th Avenue through the Bethany Home intersection. The second impact occurred directly after the first, and that vehicle driver remained on scene. The teen suffered life-threatening injuries and was transported to a local valley hospital.

Glendale Police Vehicular Crimes Detectives assumed the investigation. Detectives are looking for either a tan, white, or grey midsize 4-door passenger car with dark tint, with possible front end damage to the grill and hood. The teenager, a Phoenix resident, was declared deceased this morning. His name will not be released due to his juvenile status. Glendale Police are asking for the public's assistance.
