Glendale Police Seek Information in Hit-and-Run Accident

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On June 22, 2017 at 10:30 PM, the Glendale Police Department responded to area of 6000 W Bethany Home Road for an accident between a vehicle and a pedestrian. They arrived and found an adult male pedestrian in critical condition. The pedestrian was transported to a local hospital but was pronounced deceased. That male has been identified at 25 year old Leland Billie.

As the investigation unfolded, it was determined the pedestrian was struck in the roadway by an unknown vehicle, that fled the scene. The vehicle was traveling westbound during the collision. The only witness on scene could not provide a description of the vehicle. They did state that there was a silver sedan following the first vehicle. The vehicle will have sustained from end damage.
