Glendale Police Landfill Operation Update

Glendale, Ariz. – The search operation for the remains of Jhessye Shockley at the Butterfield Landfill has entered its final stages. As of today, there has been no significant discovery of evidence directly connected to Jhessye’s death. The Glendale Police Department is working to coordinate and bring together those key people within our organization and our partners in the operation who have supported us during this phase of our investigation for a press conference. The press conference will provide an opportunity for the department to not only provide a message to the public, but also an opportunity for the media to meet and speak with representatives from the Glendale Police Department and some of the partners involved in the operation.

As soon as the exact date and time for the press conference is determined, the Glendale Police Public Information Office will provide that information to all media outlets in the form of a press release. In order to be fair to all media outlets involved and to allow preparation time for the press conference, the Glendale Police Department will not be providing any on camera updates or sound reference the Jhessye Shockley Investigation until that time.
