**GLENDALE POLICE DEPARTMENT
RE-ACCREDITED FOR 2009 BY THE COMMISSION ON
ACCREDITATION FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES**

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On 8/1/2009 a board from the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA) awarded re-accreditation to Chief Conrad of the Glendale Police Department. A team of assessors from CALEA conducted an assessment on April 18-22, 2009 to examine all aspects of the Glendale Police Department. This examination included an assessment of the department’s policies, procedures, management, operations, and support services.

This assessment is part of a voluntary process to gain accreditation, a highly prized recognition of professional excellence in the field of law enforcement. The goal of the assessment is to demonstrate that the Glendale Police Department is in compliance with over 400 professional standards established by CALEA. The Glendale Police Department was first accredited in the year 2000; was re-accredited in the year 2003 and again in 2006.

This is an important and prestigious achievement for the men and women of the Glendale Police Department. Members of the assessment team noted that it was obvious the Glendale Police Department was committed to the accreditation process through the leadership of Chief Steven Conrad.
