## Update: Man Dies As Result of Gunshot Wound

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – A 46 year old man named Rodney Cox Sr. died this morning as a result of a shooting that occurred at a residence located in the 15800 block of N. 61<sup>st</sup> Avenue Friday night.

On Friday March 6, 2009, at 9:15 pm, Glendale Police responded to the residence where a physical fight had occurred. The fight took place outside the house and involved Rodney Cox Sr. using a blunt force object to strike two people there. One of the persons who was hit with the blunt object drew a handgun and fired one shot at Cox, which struck him in the chest. Cox was taken to the hospital where he later died from his injuries.

The 26 year old male who was struck with the blunt object was taken to a hospital with serious injuries, but was later released. The 33 year old male who was also struck with the blunt object was not taken to the hospital and was questioned about the incident.

Investigators are still looking into how the parties knew one another. No arrests have made at this time. Charges will be reviewed by the Maricopa County Attorney's Office in regards to the person involved with the shooting.
