Glendale Police Chief Debora Black Statement on Verdict in State v. Hulsey

GLENDALE, Ariz. – The Glendale Police Department is providing the following statement on behalf of Police Chief Debora Black in regards to the verdict reached today in State v. Bryan Wayne Hulsey:

“Seven years, 5 months and 9 days ago Glendale Police Officer Tony Holly was killed in the line of duty. Today, a jury has confirmed that Brian Wayne Hulsey is guilty of murdering Tony as well as the attempted murder of Officer David Goitia. While the decision today cannot relieve the pain of losing Tony, we are hopeful that it provides some comfort for his family, our department and our community. We continue to remain steadfast in our assertion that justice for Tony and his family will prevail as we enter the penalty phase of the trial.”
