Trafficking in Stolen Property Arrest

GLENDALE, Ariz. – The Glendale Police Department's Community Policing Units worked together and made an arrest on a suspect who was stealing personal property from elderly residents at a care facility in Glendale.

On April 15, 2009, officers from the Glendale Police Department were notified of a situation in which a care worker was suspected of stealing jewelry from disabled elderly residents at a nursing home at 6700 W. Hillcrest. An investigation was initiated, and three victims who suffer from Dementia/Alzheimer's disease were identified.

In the course of the investigation, it was learned the suspect, Sean Cady, a 22 year old Phoenix resident, was a care giver at the facility. Cady would remove jewelry from the victims while they slept, then pawn the property at local pawn shops to compensate for a shortfall in his monthly income and to support a drug habit.

Officers were able to locate some of the jewelry at a local pawn shop. A search warrant was served at his residence and evidence was found to implicate his involvement. Cady was arrested at his place of employment and charged with trafficking in stolen property and theft.
